Truth Point: In Joshua chapter 13 we find that Joshua has led the nation of Israel as a warrior and from a position of power. He now leads from a position of respect and influence. What got him there was his reputation as a stable and consistent leader.

Read the following verses and determine the truth that provides stability in our life as a believer. Discuss how to apply these with your group:

Final Action Point: Finish up by reading Colossians 2:5-7:

For even though I am absent in body, nevertheless I am with you in spirit, rejoicing to see your good discipline and the stability of your faith in Christ. Therefore, as you have received Christ Jesus the Lord, so walk in Him, having been **firmly rooted** and now being built up in Him and established in your faith, just as you were instructed, and overflowing with gratitude.
