Joshua 15-17:6

Truth Point: In Joshua chapter 15 through 17 we find that Joshua is dividing the land among the people and there are many challenges to do this well. His administrative duties now require him to pursue justice and love mercy as he looks at the outcomes of his decisions.

Read the following verses to determine and discuss the action and attitude we should take:

1. Read I Corinthians 13:4-7. Discuss the practical ways these verses can help us pursue justice as we apply them.
2. Read Romans 12 1-2. In what ways can we live as a daily sacrifice? What ways did we see Jesus do this? How does this help us in areas of justice?
3. Now read Romans 12:14-21. We see commandments from God that seem contradictory to common sense when it comes to battling injustices in our loves. Review these requirements one at a time and verbalize how this action will allow us to accomplish change around us.
4. Last week we learned about the tenacity and strength of Caleb. We see in Joshua 14:12, Caleb has no problem clearing out the giants from the land he was promised. However, in Chapter 15, verse 33, we see the tribe of Judah unsuccessful in driving out the Jebusites, then in Chapter 16, verse 10, we see the Canaanites could not be “dislodged.” What happened? Was God too weak to remove the inhabitants?
5. What happens when we do not “dislodge” all that God is telling us to remove in our lives?

Final Action Point:

Pray for God to continue to make you into His image which will assist you in confronting issues of justice with love and power.
