Ephesians 6

- 1. Ephesians 6:2 tells us to "Honor our father and mother which is the first commandment with a promise." What is the promise? And, what is a natural outcome of obeying parents that makes this statement true?
- 2. Ephesians 5 & 6 have strong parallels with Colossians chapter 3. How does the attitude Paul impresses upon slaves and masters in Ephesians 6:5-9 compare with Colossians 3:17?
- 3. Even though slavery is very rare, why is our attitude about work and those we work for so important to our discipleship?
- 4. Consider and discuss how your life will look when you "armor-up."
- 5. In the very last verse of Ephesians, the New American Standard version states "with an incorruptible love." Check out another version to help better understand this phrase. How do we know we have this type of love?
