

**So That You Will KNOW**

I Kings 18:16-19 / Mark 2:1-12

- 1). God loves to *demonstrate* to us that He is real and that His word is truth.
- 2). The Old Testament is filled with such demonstrations.
- 3). A favorite: Elijah on Mt. Carmel in 1 Kings 18.
- 4). The New Testament witness to Jesus and the Apostles seems to take it to a whole new level.
- 5). The Apostles and writers of the NT seemed especially obsessed with “demonstrating” the truth of The Way.
- 6). Jesus really set the stage for His followers.
- 7). The Resurrection as the “Great Sign” for an unbelieving generation.
- 8). Mark 2, the healing of the paralytic, as a key passage showing that Jesus loves to objectively demonstrate the truth of His identity and His teaching.
- 9). God wants us to KNOW.

**Four reflection questions**

- 1). Apart from the example with Elijah on Mr. Carmel in 1 Kings 18, what other “demonstrations” of God’s reality, knowledge, and power do you see in the Old Testament?
- 2). What “demonstration” were the disciples seemingly obsessed with, and why?
- 3). What is the main point of Jesus healing the paralytic after forgiving his sins?
- 4). What is the relationship between “knowledge” and “faith” in biblical Christianity?

**Two application questions**

- 1). If you have never seen a miracle (a demonstration) take place personally, can you still claim to have knowledge that God exists and Christianity is true?
- 2). God was not always doing miracles of demonstration through the Apostles as they preached the Gospel throughout their world, so how did they convince people of the reality of God and the truth of Christianity? How would you convince people?
