

TRUTH FOR LIFE (Application):
1. Forgiveness is about the offense, not ignoring the sin.
NOTE: There is a difference between a and a sin.
2. Forgiveness is to be by us and the is to be born by us.
3. Forgiveness is not limited by or events.
4. Forgiveness may not always in reconciliation, but reconciliation should be the desire of the forgiver.
5. Forgiveness is one of the clearest evidences of gospel

### Dig Deeper:

- I. Why is it so hard for us to forgive others for wrongs they have committed against us?
- 2. In what ways do we often put limits on forgiveness like Peter wanted or worse, seek revenge? What does that reveal about our hearts?
- 3. How does the previous section (vv. 15-20) relate to Jesus' teaching on forgiveness? What is the correlation?
- 4. How does the command of I Peter 4:8 relate to learning how to release an offense?
- 5. In light of Hebrews 12:15, how might unforgiveness poison your life?
- What can we learn about forgiveness from the ministry of Christ? Study: Matthew 9:2-8; Luke 7:44-50; John 8:3-11; John 18:27; and John 21:13-19
