

## THE MIND OF CHRIST

Philippians 2:5-6 (NKJV)

<sup>5</sup> Let this mind be in you which was also in Christ Jesus, <sup>6</sup> who, being in the form of God, did not consider it robbery to be equal with God, <sup>7</sup> but made Himself of no reputation, taking the form of a bondservant, and coming in the likeness of men. <sup>8</sup> And being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself and became obedient to the point of death, even the death of the cross.

### 1. God Requires Humility

Proverbs 3:34

Toward the scorners He is scornful, but to the humble He gives grace.

1 Peter 5:5

Likewise, you who are younger, be subject to the elders. Clothe yourselves, all of you, with humility toward one another, for “God opposes the proud but gives grace to the humble.”

James 4:6

But He gives more grace. Therefore, it says, “God opposes the proud but gives grace to the humble.”

Christian maturity is not finally having all the answers, but surrendering daily to the one who controls all the problems

Romans 12:16

Live in harmony with one another. Do not be haughty, but associate with the lowly. Never be wise in your own sight.

### 2. If you want peace, trust God to be in control of everything.

Isaiah 26:3

You will keep in perfect peace those whose minds are steadfast, because they trust in you.

Romans 8:5-6

<sup>5</sup> For those who live according to the flesh set their minds on the things of the flesh, but those who live according to the Spirit set their minds on the things of the Spirit.

<sup>6</sup> For to set the mind on the flesh is death, but to set the mind on the Spirit is life and peace.
