weeks ahead.

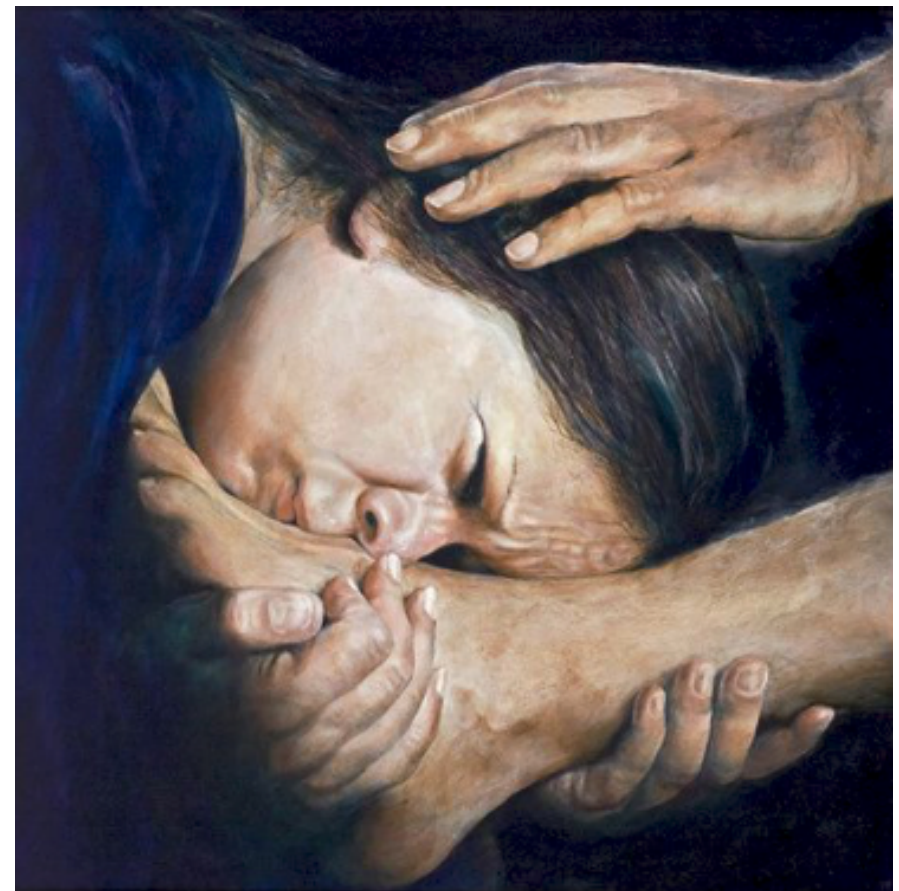
Interested in Joining Cornerstone?
