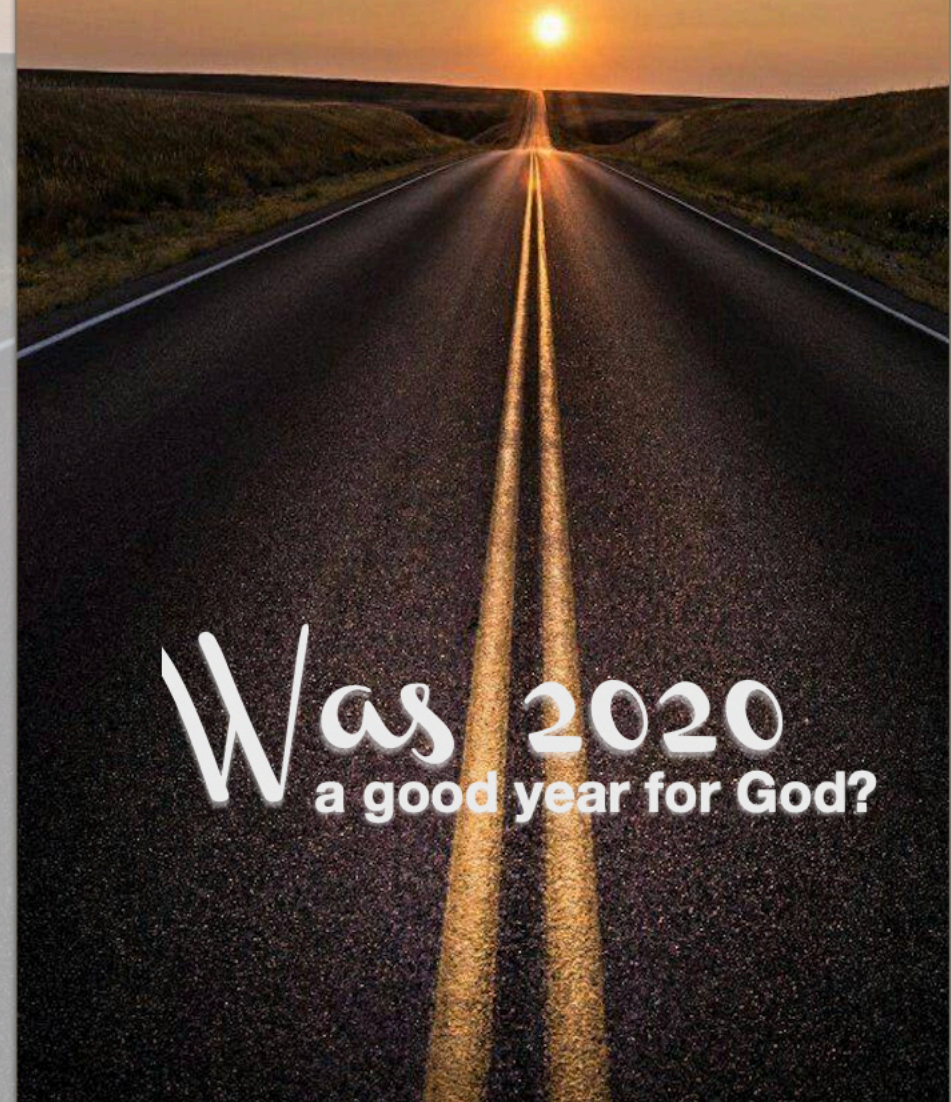

**Truth Point:** In John chapter 6, Jesus gave a very difficult message to the disciples concerning eating His flesh and drinking His blood. He then helped them understand an important aspect of living for Christ.

His answer is verses 60 – 63:

Upon hearing it, many of his disciples said, “This is a hard teaching. Who can accept it?”

61 Aware that his disciples were grumbling about this, Jesus said to them, “Does this offend you? 62 Then what if you see the Son of Man ascend to where he was before! 63 The Spirit gives life; **the flesh counts for nothing**. The words I have spoken to you—they are full of the Spirit and life.

**Reflection and Action Points:**

1. Are you relying on your own power, initiative, actions, or any other thing than the Holy Spirit to fulfill your life?
2. What does it look like to live a spirit filled life?
3. Do the words of Jesus saying “I am the bread of life” in John 6:35 help you understand where your focus should be?
4. Next week, Ethan Marrs will be discussing “Will 2021 be a good year for God?” How would you answer that now, knowing what Jesus is requiring from you?

**Final Action Point:** Discuss the wonderful benefits of living for Christ and not yourself. Would you have more peace of mind? Would you be enjoying more loving relationships? Would God be working through you more to do His will?
