

Joshua 8

Sunday, January 10, 2021

Truth Point: God promises victory to us in His word. Many verses are promises with a premise. The premise presented in the verse is the key to unlocking the promise. In the following verses, please search for the premise that leads to victory.

I John 5:4 Ephesians 6:13 James 1:2-5 I John 1:9 Proverbs 21:31

Failure: We learned on Sunday that God uses our past failures and even our past painful experiences to bring us to a place of victory.

- 1. Contemplate on past hurts or failures that God has turned around and used to bless you. If possible, share those with the group.
- 2. Do we look down on those who have failed in the past? What should be our attitude and actions to those who are hurting around us?
- 3. Please read Luke 7:39-50. In this passage we find a person with much sin who has an advantage. What is the message of this passage?

Final Action Point: Now is a good time to count your blessings. When we realize that our sins are great and worthy of God's wrath, yet forgiven, we can see clearly that God is very good to us. Share the goodness you are grateful for with the group. Please close by first reading Romans 2:4 and answering the question Paul asks. Then take some time thanking God for His kindness.
