

Study Guide

Joshua 9 - Depending on God

Sunday, January 24, 2021

Truth Point: In Joshua chapter 9, we find that Joshua and the leaders are fooled by the Gibeonites. We are also told that Joshua did not seek God's counsel before making a decision.

Reflection and Action Points:

- I. Joshua had just read the law to the people and was aware of God's principles he should follow. But when it came to making a good decision, he did not consult God. How do we consult God on a daily basis to make sure we are getting direction from Him?
- 2. What other scripture passages help us to understand and guide us to a deeper dependence on God?
- 3. Discuss the principles in Proverbs 3:1-12. Which ones do you currently apply and which ones could you be better at?
- 4. Discuss all the ways John 15:5 applies to our walk with Christ.

Final Action Point: Finish up by reading Isaiah 50:10 and discuss how to apply this truth. Then pray for the others in your group that they would also be daily depending on God.
