Application Questions (for individual or small group use):

- I. In what ways does our pagan culture demand loyalty from us?
- 2. What struck you most about Polycarp's last words before he was burned at the stake?
- 3. Why do we so often believe that when we are in tribulation Christ is far and does not care? What words of His can we take comfort from in this letter?
- 4. The church at Smyrna was willing to suffer much to be faithful to the end. What prevents us from having this willingness? If large-scale persecution broke out in our country, what do you think would be the result in our churches?
- 5. Jesus mentions that the devil is the one who threw the believers into prison and that some of the persecutors were of the "synagogue of Satan." What does this tell us about the nature of spiritual warfare? Read: Ephesians 6:12;1 Peter 5:8-9.
- 6. Jesus told the church that they would have tribulation (v. 10). How does this relate to John 16:33 and 2 Timothy 3:12
- 7. What is the second death (see Revelation 20:6, 14 for clues)? How does not being hurt by the second death relate to being an overcomer (victor)?
- 8. Smyrna was one of two churches to not receive any correction or rebuke from lesus? What do you think kept them pure?
