Revelation Bible Class on Hold

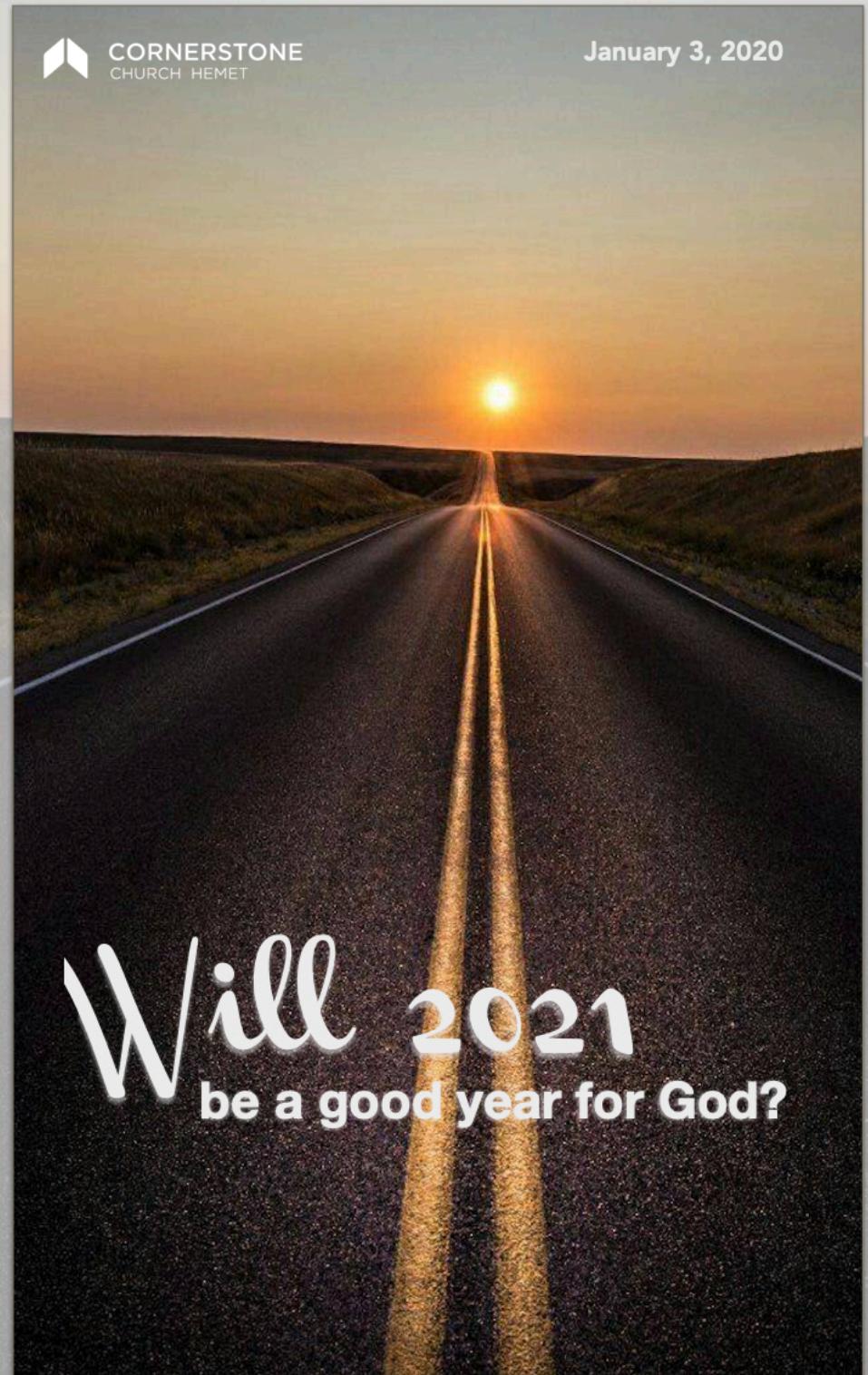
The Sunday AM Bible Study class is postponed for a few weeks until we get past flu/virus season. Watch for updates on the schedule.
