Matthew 11

This man of God, John the Baptist, is most likely in prison right now about to be decapitated by a wicked ruler. [See Matthew 14:1-12] In this dark season of the soul, John sends some disciples to question whether or not Jesus is the coming one or if they seek another.

- Jesus loved John. They were cousins; their moms would visit each other. John baptized Jesus and was the one who prepared the way. What was Jesus' opinion of John? [See verse 7-19]
- 2) But John's disciples didn't hear verse 7-19 before they departed. What was the answer from Jesus which John's disciples went back to tell him? [see verse 4-6]
- 3) These words reference the prophecies written from Isaiah 29:18-19. Why would this be significant to answering John's question?
- 4) What does this teach us about true rest and true encouragement? Do we learn a difference between resting in the encouragement of the Word and promises of God versus resting in our self worth and others' opinions of us?
