We can divide our text into 3 parts:

1. Paul is frustrated with this church (17-22)
 - a. Divisions existed among them
 - b. They weren't meeting to eat the the Lord's Supper
2. Paul compared their dinner to Jesus' last supper with His disciples (23-32)
3. Paul states the conclusion of his teaching: wait for one another (33-34)
