Joshua 13:1

Sunday, March 21, 2021

Truth Point: In Joshua chapter 13, we find that Joshua is being challenged to continue the work that he started of possessing the land that God promised to the Jewish nation. However, Joshua is getting old. God will still use Joshua, but the way God will use Joshua will change.

Read the following verses to determine and discuss the action and attitude we should take:

1. In Joshua 13:6, what does God say that He will do? How is this different than what God was doing up to this time? Are there times in your life where God has done something similar? Discuss God's working in your life with the group.

2. In verse 1 of chapter 13, we find that Joshua is old. Most likely he was around 100 years old. Joshua will not see his work continue but not completed. Why do you think this happens? What should we learn from this?

3. We see that Joshua will move from being a warrior to being an administrator. As we get older, we need to learn to move from being successful to significant in the lives of others, especially younger people. Do you have a plan to mentor someone in your life? When should mentoring start? Did you have a mentor in your life? Discuss this in your group.

4. Read Leviticus 19:32. How shall we treat the older people in our lives?

5. Read I Timothy 4:12. How should the older people treat the younger people? What can we do to encourage this?

Final Action Point:

Pray for the ministry of Cornerstone Church. God has uniquely gifted us with many generations of members. Knowing this, what needs in our church and neighborhood can we meet because of this uniqueness?
