Dig Deeper Questions:

- 1) How does the coming of the Holy Spirit to fill the early believers expand your view on God's overarching plan for us and his church? How does this event relate to the bigger picture?
- 2) Pentecost followed 50 days after the resurrection of Jesus and 10 days after the Ascension of Jesus. What might be the significance of the order of these three significant events within a short two-month span?
- 3) How does Acts 2:5 related to Revelation 5:9 and 7:9?
- 4) In v. 14, what do you notice about Peter that was different from his cowardly denial of Christ at Jesus' trial (Matt. 26:75)? What was the reason for this difference? What does this teach us about boldness?
- 5) How does verse 13 and verse 21 provide clarity on how people respond to God's promise and provision? Who are you trying to reach with the gospel? Who are you praying for?
