Sermon Notes

Ephesians 4:1-16

- 1. Paul builds his case for how we as followers of Christ should act and live.
- 2. In Chapter 4, Paul moves from describing the "what and why" purposes of following Christ to "how" we are to follow Christ.
- 3. Paul explains that we are all given gifts that enable us to work together to accomplish ministry according to His purpose.
- 4. Paul emphasizes that we are to speak the truth in love and understand that the "proper working of the body" must be done in love.
- 5. In future chapters we see Paul continue his instruction on how we follow Christ as the church body, then the immediate family, and ultimately the individual.

Study Notes

Ephesians 4:1-16

- 1. Paul tells us to "walk in a manner worthy of the calling with which you have been called." What does this mean?
- 2. Paul tells us what is needed to be "diligent to preserve the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace." What is needed?
- 3. In verse 8, he tell us that "He gave gifts to men." Do you know what gifts He has given you? If so, do you know how to use your gift?
- 4. Please describe the difference between teaching and discipleship.
- 5. Are there areas of "tacit approval" in your life that you need to correct? In other words, do you need to be more loving to confront some areas of weakness or sin in another person's life? Remember that we are only to do this "in love" so that we build up the body of Christ.
- 6. Remember that you can always say "no" to something when there is ____ burning inside you!
