Truth Point: In Joshua 17, Joshua must address the lack of fortitude and resolve that the tribes of Manasseh and Ephraim display. Instead of reminding them of the promise of God, which he has done many times before, he now uses their own statements against them to help them see the true problem.

Read the following verses to determine and discuss the action and attitude we should take:

1. Read Mark 11:22-24. What is the action that we are to understand from this verse?
2. Read Hebrews 11:6. This verse tells us how to please God. In your own words, what is the unique difference between doing things for God, and implementing what this verse encourages us to do?
3. Now read 1 Corinthians 2:5. With this verse we understand where we are to place our faith. What happens when we do not follow this truth?
4. In James 1:5-8 we are shown practical knowledge on asking God for help in faith without _____. What is this requirement for asking in faith? Discuss how to apply this verse to your prayer life. When praying in a group, what is a good exercise to include to follow the wisdom in this verse?
5. Mark 9:23 Fill in the blank: “All things are possible for one who _____.”
