- 1. By being a part of the Body of Christ, we experience God in us, through us, and around us.
- 2. There are "horizontal" blessings in the Body of Christ. When you come into relationship with Jesus, you come into relationship with other believers. We are brothers and sisters because of being in Christ.

The Body of Christ

 In 1 Corinthians 3:21-23 Paul states:
21 So then let no one boast in men. For all things belong to you, 22 whether Paul or Apollos or Cephas or the world or life or death or things present or things to come; all things belong to you, 23 and you belong to Christ; and Christ belongs to God.

What prompted Paul to make this statement? What was he addressing in the previous verses?

- 2. Discuss in your group all the things that Christ shares with us throughout eternity? Does this statement from Paul change the way we see eternity?
- 3. Knowing that all things are shared with us, does that change our way of thinking, our attitude, and our actions now? Do are material possessions seem less important in this context?
- 4. Paul also states "you belong to Christ." Are we acting like Christ "owns" us?
- 5. Now read Romans 12:1-3 and discuss how Christ expects us to act.
