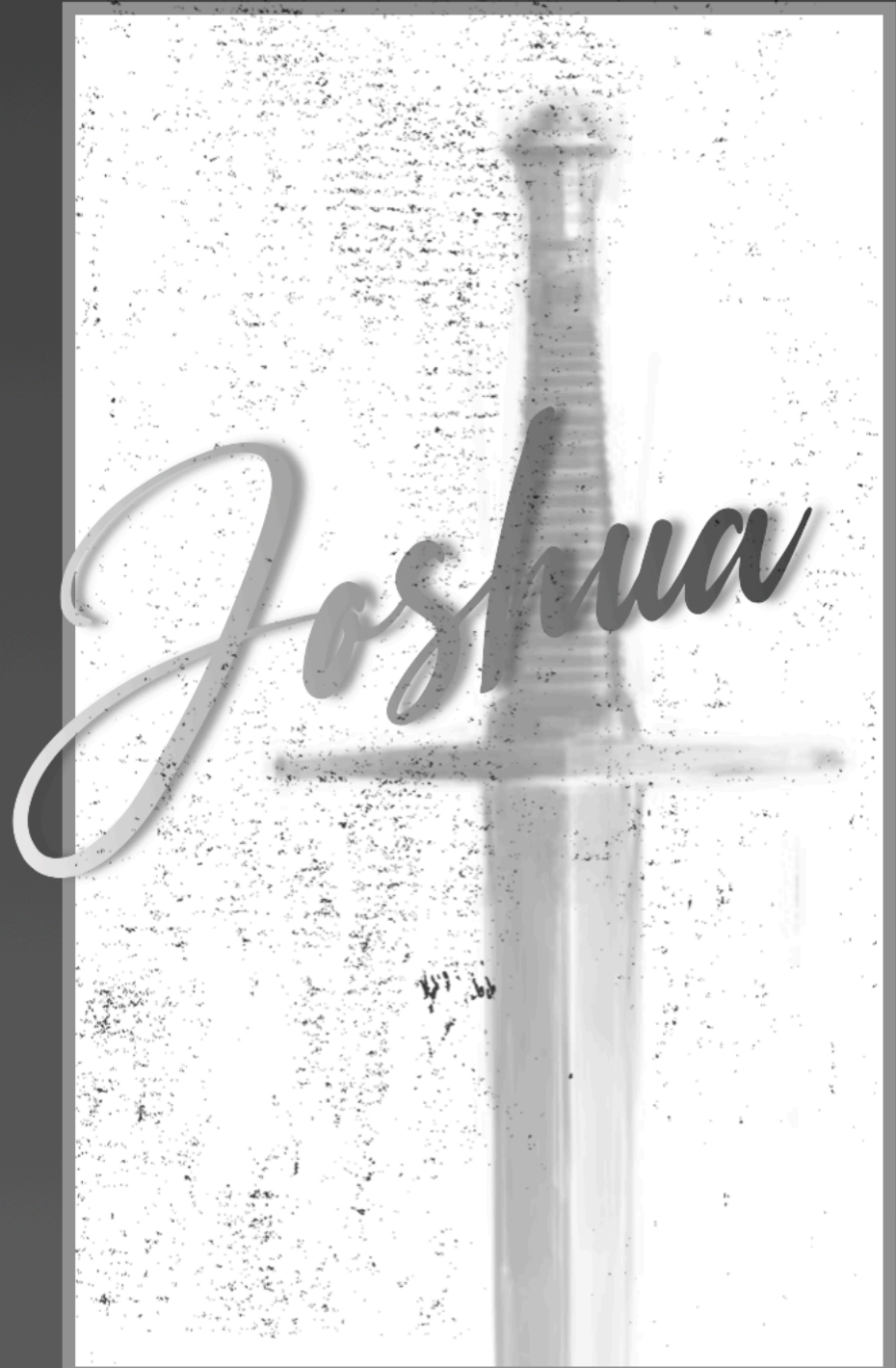
Visiting with us today? Please stop by the Lobby Info Center for a free gift and an opportunity to learn more about Cornerstone Hemet.

Joshua 7:16-8:2

Sunday, November 29, 2020

Take some time to read through Psalm 139, focusing especially on the last two verses [23 & 24]. Read in the spirit of the text, "Search me, O God, and know my heart; try me, and know my anxieties; And see if there is any wicked way in me, and lead me in the way everlasting." Spend time reflecting in prayer over these matters:

- 1) Lord, is there a particular sin I harbor in the tent of my heart? If so, take time for confession before the Father who loves you.
- 2) In reflecting on that point, what judgment would the Lord have you swiftly execute? Let us not hesitate.
- 3) Now, with that settled at the cross, spend time meditating on the complete work of Christ and His life. How does the Lord see you? And where would He have you go? Who would He have you be? Bring that to Him and in His strength let us move into the mountain lands of His holiness.
