Joshua Chapter 3

October 11, 2020

Truth Point: We learned that Joshua was going to be exalted as the leader. For every journey there is a first step. Joshua was now going to see the result of obedience that God required from him in Joshua 1. Joshua would have to be strong and courageous in order to accomplish what God wanted him to do.

Reflection and Action Points:

1. The first test of Joshua's courage was to lead the people through an uncrossable river. Are there times when you find yourself having to defend your actions when following after God? Are you purposefully around people who need to see your faith in action?
2. God has Joshua tell the people to consecrate themselves because God was about to do something amazing. Why was consecration necessary? What times in our lives might this be required more than other times?
3. In Joshua 3:7 God explains why He will exalt Joshua. If you find yourself in a position of power or authority, why would God be putting you there? How will you accomplish what He wants from you?
4. Is there something that you now need to start doing but just haven't done it? The children of Israel had to get their feet wet and take that first step. What is your first step that will get your feet wet?

Final Action Point:

Pray specifically for the strength of others in your group that they would see where God is leading them, consecrate themselves before God, and take that first step of faith.
