more at the Info Desk

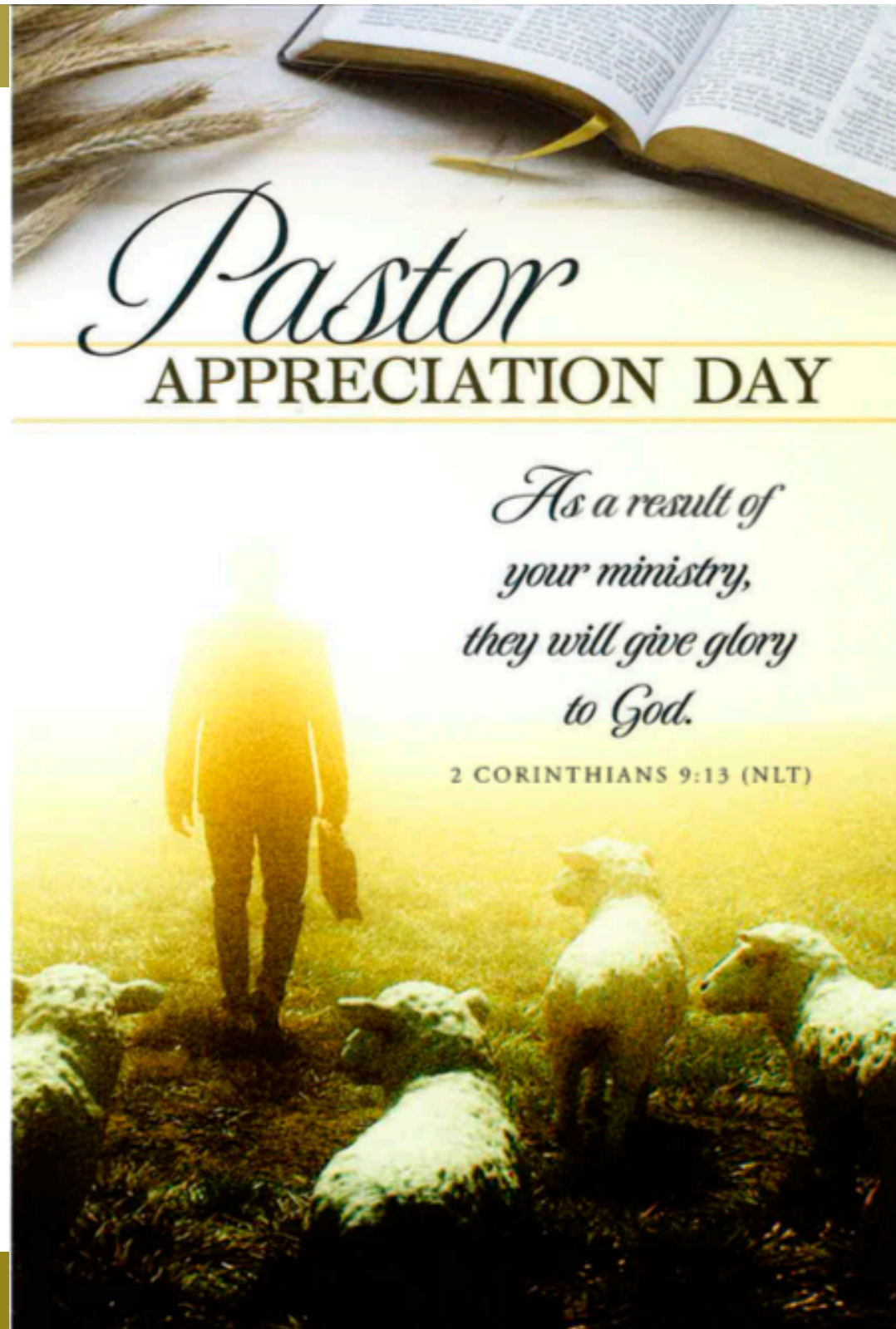
Chili Cook-Off & Fall Festival - Next
