

Joshua Chapter I

September 27, 2020

Truth Point: We learned that Joshua had to prepare for battle. He knew that this would be a long series of battles to take over many small kingdoms, fortified cities, and powerful armies.

Reflection Points:

- 1. God required obedience from Joshua by telling him to specifically do something in Joshua 1:7&8. Does this commandment apply to you? If so, what do you need to change which will help you obey God?
- 2. God tells Joshua three times in the first chapter of Joshua to be "strong and courageous." Why did God repeat this statement three times?
- 3. Why did Joshua give the people three days (verse 11) before entering the promised land? Is there something in this advice that we need to follow?
- 4. What attributes of Joshua can you relate with? Are you ready to lead, if called? Are you ready to claim God's promises to those around you?
- 5. God promises to be with Joshua in Joshua 1. Is there a place in the New Testament where God promises to be with you?

Action Points:

- 1. At the conclusion of Joshua 1, the people make a commitment to follow. How strong are your commitments? Do you need to "recommit" to your service to the Lord?
- 2. Is there a commandment to Joshua that you find overwhelming? What is that command and why does it trouble you?
