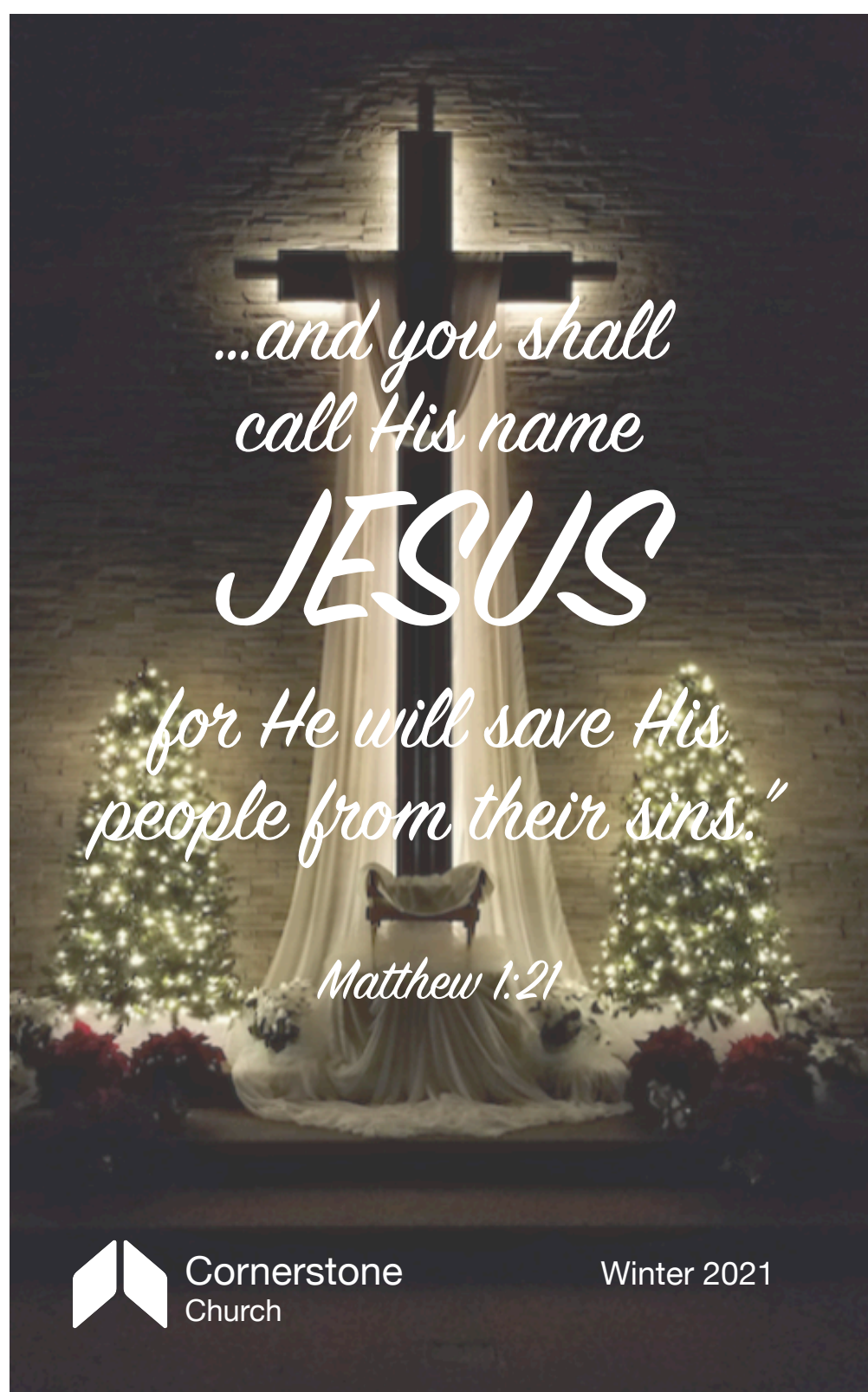
Thank you to all who contributed to our annual Christmas program and fair. A tremendous amount of work was put in to making it another success, and our prayer is that God was glorified in our efforts!
